Directions: Select ONE of the following summer projects. It is due sometime during the week of September 14th - exact date to follow when school opens.

1. **Draw your family tree...** as we reviewed during this school year. If your family is small, make it up! Use as much of the family vocabulary as you can. Make it colorful and perhaps, you may want to put pictures in the tree and not just words. Maybe you like to draw and that's OK. Pets also count as family! Remember to give everyone a name. It must be in Italian - like 'la sorella'/the sister with her name.

Part two of this project will require you to write 2 sentences in Italian about the family member. This is where you may use descriptive adjectives... even if you make things up! Be creative and have fun! Don't forget to conjugate the verbs! This is done on a separate page.

This can be on standard paper or even generated on the computer. But it must be your work! Have fun with it!

2. **Compare the Italian Mediterranean diet** to the American diet. We discussed this somewhat in class. (Remember the McDonald's in Italy?) How are they different and how are they similar? Which is better and why do you think so?

This may be done as a report, a Venn diagram or a pyramid. It must be your work with at least, 3 sources cited. The information may be written in English with Italian used for the Italian food items mentioned.
