Spectators Code of Conduct

The Salesian High School Student (SHS) *Spectator Code of Conduct* is formed and established to set policy regarding expectations of spectators while in attendance at a school athletic event. Spectators in attendance at school sporting events, whether they are parents/guardians or guests of the opposing team, are encouraged to actively support their teams and the students present.

Terms of the *Code of Conduct*

- Spectators are encouraged to attend contests for the purpose of recreation and enjoyment, but also to provide positive support and encouragement to the teams, coaches and school.
- Spectators are expected to maintain a positive behavior and attitude at all athletic contests. Enthusiastic cheering for one's own team is always encouraged, but direct remarks towards officials, coaches/players and other guests shall be avoided.
- Spectators are expected to refrain from the use of foul/disparaging language while in attendance at games. The generation of artificial noise (i.e. no ringing of bells, sounds of horns, or other noisemakers) at contests during play is not allowed.
- Spectators are asked to refrain from interacting with any coach, player or official during the course of a game.
- **Violation of the Spectator's Code of Conduct: In the event a spectator's actions are in violation of the SHS Spectator Code of Conduct the individual may be asked to leave the premises, and be subject to possible ban from future sporting events.**
